## GENERAL COMMENTS

The FOB Gulf DDGS to SBM spread for this week was \$112, up from \$105 last week. The FOB Gulf DDGS to corn spread is \$47.68, down from \$49.58 last week. Ethanol production in the United States averaged 1.113 million barrels per day (bpd) in the week ended Feb. 20, down 5,000 bpd week-on-week and 32,000 bpd, or 3%, higher than in the same week last year.

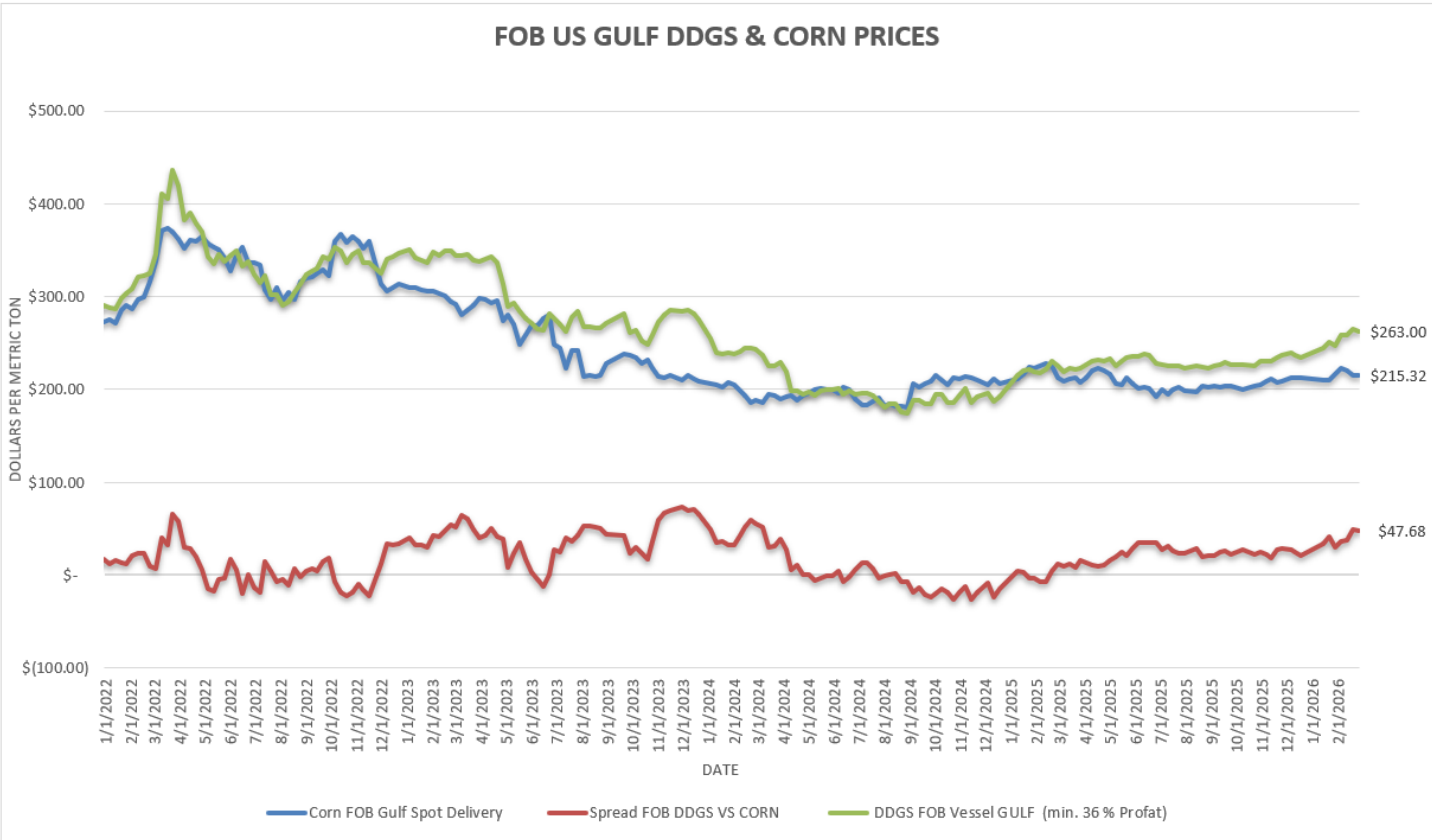
