PLANNING GUIDE

The U.S. Grains Council will be holding its 19th International Marketing Conference & 62nd Annual Membership Meeting in Greenville, South Carolina. All meetings will be taking place in-person with a virtual option to stream our Monday and Wednesday morning general sessions.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Make reservations online at the Council's website, www.grains.org/greenville, or by calling the hotel's reservations department at (864) 235-1234 and mentioning the U.S. Grains Council meeting to receive the discounted rate. The reservations deadline is Friday, Jan. 14, 2022. After this date, the hotel will accept reservations on a space-available basis.

The Council has negotiated a room rate of \$189 USD per night, single or double occupancy, plus a 10 percent tax and a 2 percent destination fee. Check-in time is 4 p.m.; check-out time is 11 a.m.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The Hyatt Regency Greenville is approximately 20 minutes from the Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport (airport code: GSP). The hotel provides a complimentary shuttle to and from the airport, all reservations can be made by calling the hotel (864) 235-1234.

Transportation to the hotel via taxi will cost approximately \$28 one-way. Uber or Lyft are available at an estimated cost of \$27 one-way.
